

**March 21, 2022**

The Mitchell County Commissioners met in formal session on Monday, March 21, 2022 with Chairman Mike Cooper and members Jim Marshall and Tom Claussen in attendance. Also in attendance was Terry Bailey, KVSV Radio.

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The minutes of the March 14, 2022 meeting were approved as written on motion by Jim Marshall and seconded by Tom Claussen. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

Tony Miller, CASA Representative, presented a proclamation to the commission to declare April as "Child Abuse Prevention Month". The commission approved the proclamation on motion by Tom Claussen and seconded by Jim Marshall. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

EMS Director Eric Hamel requested permission to purchase two (2) 800 MgHz radios for his department. One for the Expedition and one for the Cawker City station. There are no radios or money available through homeland security for such use and the commission approved paying \$5,189.53 for two radios from Henry Pierce with ARPA funds on motion by Jim Marshall and seconded by Tom Claussen. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

Cortney Murrow, County Health Administrator, discussed removal of trees around the Health Department Building. She presented bids for the work but after discussion the County and City crews will do the work of removal. Mrs. Murrow also stated that she had purchased a new metal sign for the outside of the Health Department Building.

A Neighborhood Revitalization Application was approved for Boettcher Supply, LLC in the amount of \$90,110 on motion by Jim Marshall and seconded by Tom Claussen. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:45 on motion by Jim Marshall and seconded by Tom Claussen. Motion carried by unanimous vote.
