

## April 4, 2022

The Mitchell County Commissioners met in formal session on Monday, April 4, 2022 with Chairman Mike Cooper and members Jim Marshall and Tom Claussen in attendance. Also in attendance was Terry Bailey, KSVV Radio, and Caleb Bowers, attending for his Leadership Mitchell County process.

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The minutes of the March 28, 2022 meeting were approved as written on motion by Tom Claussen and seconded by Jim Marshall. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

Emily Benedick, Community Development Director, and Julia Rabe, Beloit Chamber Director, discussed the low to moderate income housing program. They also discussed the Murals in Mitchell County Program. The kick-off for this program will be April 18, 2022. The Solomon Valley Foundation gave \$1,000 for each city in the County for the project.

Cortney Murrow, County Health Administrator, reported to the commission that the State is transitioning from a COVID pandemic to an endemic. She also stated that they are doing some testing at the health department for COVID. District Sanitarian Sherry Koster's position was discussed. There will need to be a replacement found for her as neither the Health Department or the County Clerk want to take on the responsibility.

The commission approved a proclamation declaring April as Sexual Assault Awareness Month on motion by Jim Marshall and seconded by Tom Claussen. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:15 on motion by Tom Claussen and seconded by Jim Marshall. Motion carried by unanimous vote.
