

May 6, 2019

The Mitchell County Commissioners met in formal session on Monday, May 6, 2019 at 8:30 a.m. in the Commissioner's Room of the Mitchell County Courthouse. Present were Chairman Mike Cooper and members Jim Marshall and Tom Claussen. Also present was Terry Bailey, KSVV Radio.

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The minutes of the April 22, 2019 and April 29, 2019 waiver were approved as written on motion by Tom Claussen and seconded by Jim Marshall. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

Dale Housh, Public Works Supervisor reported that they are working on a bridge on Lucy Trail. Posts are being replaced on the causeway and the oiler is hopefully repaired. A crane purchase was discussed.

A Neighborhood Revitalization application was approved for Gold Standard Farms in the amount of \$375,000 on motion by Tom Claussen and seconded by Jim Marshall. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

The commission met with Loren Remus concerning a bridge on H Rd just south and west of the Moss Bridge (230 Rd). He reported that the gravel placed over the decking of the bridge is too thick and sloppy for crossing. He also stated that he had been the one who removed the gravel from the bridge and placed it up the hill. The commission assured Mr. Remus that they would try to correct this issue.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:10 on motion by Jim Marshall and seconded by Tom Claussen. Motion carried by unanimous vote.
