

**June 3, 2019**

The Mitchell County Commissioners met in formal session on Monday, June 3, 2019 at 8:30 a.m. in the Commissioner's Room of the Mitchell County Courthouse. Present were Chairman Mike Cooper and members Jim Marshall and Tom Claussen. Also present was Jason Rabe, Beloit City Manager; Heather Hartman, Community Development Director; and Terry Bailey, KVSV Radio.

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The minutes of the May 28, 2019 meeting were approved as written on motion by Tom Claussen and seconded by Jim Marshall. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

Noxious Weed Director Stan Deneke announced that he is resigning his position as of the end of 2019.

A Neighborhood Revitalization Application was approved for Ron Tice in the amount of \$200,000 on motion by Tom Claussen and seconded by Jim Marshall. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

Pawnee Mental Health Executive Director Robbin Cole and PMH Board Members Kathy Webster & Terry Bailey, and therapists Gilletta Mollerker, Charlene Trost and Myra Pfeifer presented Pawnee's budget request for 2020. They are requesting a 3 ½% increase in funding.

Stan Deneke, Noxious Weed Director, met with the commission who requested an executive session for non-elected personnel for 15-minutes on motion by Jim Marshall and seconded by Tom Claussen. Motion carried by unanimous vote. County Clerk was asked to remain in session. Session began at 9:52 and ended at 10:07 with no decisions made in executive session.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:15 on motion by Jim Marshall and seconded by Tom Claussen. Motion carried by unanimous vote.
