The Mitchell County Commissioners met in formal session on Monday, July 18, 2022 with Chairman Mike Cooper and members Tom Claussen and Jim Marshall in attendance. Also in attendance was Terry Bailey, KVSV Radio.

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The minutes of the June 11, 2022 meeting were approved as written on motion by Tom Claussen and seconded by Jim Marshall. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

Eric Hamel, EMS, provided his regular monthly report. He requested, and was granted on motion by Tom Claussen and seconded by Jim Marshall, a 10-minute executive session for trade secrets of a corporation per KSA 75-4318. Motion carried by unanimous vote. Session began at 9:00 and ended at 9:10 when it was extended 5-minutes on motion by Tom Claussen and seconded by Jim Marshall. Motion carried by unanimous vote. Session ended at 9:15 with no decisions made in executive session.

Marty Hernandez, Public Works, had the commission sign paperwork for the Cawker City Causeway project. Mitchell County will bear 10% of the cost and Federal and State funding will pay the other 90%. The paperwork was signed on motion by Jim Marshall and seconded by Tom Claussen. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

John Shea, new Director for the North Central Regional Planning Commission stopped to introduce himself to the commission.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:25 on motion by Jim Marshall and seconded by Tom Claussen. Motion carried by unanimous vote.
